

## Creativity, activity, service (CAS)

### What is the CAS?

CAS is divided into three components Creativity, Activity, Service. CAS is a vital part of the IB core as well as plays an important role in moulding the students as a critical thinker, inquirers, develops empathy and mindfulness.

### What skills would I develop through CAS?

Students develop skills and attitudes through a variety of individual and group activities that provide students with opportunities to express their passions, personalities and perspectives. During the CAS activities you learn things by doing and this core component will teach you how to plan, analyze, act, evaluate and reflect for your own positive growth.

### Are there levels (SL/HL) in CAS?

CAS is an important element of DP core hence does not have any levels (SL or HL).

### What kind of support will be provided at Neev for CAS?

CAS is majorly depended on students initiation and planning. We at neev will provide great number of opportunities and resources to develop new skills and experiences. Expert visits, Field trips and research team will help students to channelize their ideas/projects towards a right direction.

### How is the CAS assessed?

CAS will not be assessed, however students must show the evidences of their experiences on the seven learning outcomes in their CAS portfolio. It is mandatory for students to complete/meet the CAS expectations for getting IB Diploma. At the end of year 12 students will be having an CAS exit interview to share their experiences and any life changing moments.

### How will CAS help me later?

System of self-evaluation, real life experiences encourages students to reflect on the benefits of CAS participation to themselves and to others. CAS experiences makes students to think about the ethical issues and motivates them to extend their knowledge and service towards the community and own growth. Students authentic CAS initiatives will add more weightage to their individual profile, university applications and more than that it will give the self satisfaction of learning through service.
